

Barron's: Natural Gas Took a Dive. A Warmer Winter Could Keep Prices Down.

By Oct. 21, gas prices posted six consecutive session declines to shave that year-to-date climb to 33%. “2022 has not been a normal year for U.S. and global gas supply and demand fundamentals,” says Walter Kunisch, senior commodities strategist at HTS Commodities, a division of HilltopSecurities.
